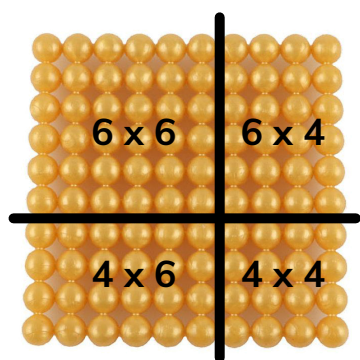

Example



$$10 \times 10 = 100$$

$$6 \times 6 = 36$$

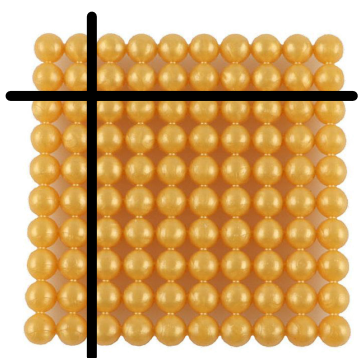
$$6 \times 4 = 24$$

$$4 \times 6 = 24$$

$$4 \times 4 = 16$$

$$36 + 24 + 24 + 16 = 100$$
